

RESPONDENT RIGHTS

The following rights are guaranteed to the respondent in the student conduct process.

These rights can also be found in the Student Rights & Responsibilities Guide located at <http://www.ubalt.edu/studenthandbook>

1. The right to notice of the charge(s) brought against them.
2. The right to share their understanding of the situation and present relevant information and/or documentation for consideration in accordance with established procedures before a final decision is rendered.
3. The right to bring one person for support to a conduct meeting.
4. The right to review relevant information that has been presented for consideration in the adjudication process in accordance with established procedures.
5. The right to have the decision made using a preponderance of the evidence.
6. The right to be informed of the final outcome and adjudication decision.
7. The right to appeal the adjudication decision in accordance with established procedures for appeal(s).
