



English Proficiency Waiver

The English language test score may be waived* if:

- first-time undergraduate applicants have completed three or more years of study at a U.S. high school.
- transfer applicants have completed 56 or more transferable credits, including a grade of 'C' or higher in English composition, at an accredited college or university in the United States.
- the student has been awarded a degree from:

United States
Australia
Ireland
New Zealand
United Kingdom
Anglophone Africa: Botswana, Ethiopia, Eswatini, Gambia, Ghana, Lesotho, Liberia, Kenya, Malawi, Namibia, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, and Zimbabwe
Anglophone Canada: Everywhere except Quebec and Nunavut
British Commonwealth Caribbean: Antigua, the Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Jamaica, Montserrat, St. Kitts/Nevis/Anguilla, St. Lucia, St. Vincent, Trinidad and Tobago, and Turks and Caicos.

***If you qualify for a waiver, the English test score will be waived upon receipt of your official U.S. Transcript and/or International Transcript Evaluation.**
