There is a surcharge of \$50 per credit (graduate business), \$89 per credit (graduate liberal arts) and \$59 per credit (undergraduate) for online web classes. Tuition/fees and books/supplies are estimated for the 9-month academic year. Living expenses for accompanying family dependents (spouse and/or children) are an additional \$2,500 per person per year. Living expenses are estimated for the 12-month calendar year at \$12,000, based on a single student living with a roommate:

Rent, Telephone and Utilities	\$ 400 per month
Food and Household Supplies	\$ 300 per month
Personal Expenses (medical insurance/care, clothing, local transportation, recreation, personal needs)	\$ 300 per month
Settling-in Expenses (hotel, meals, deposits for rent, telephone and utilities, etc.)	\$1,000 one time
