Using the Multistate Performance Test, students will hone their critical reading and legal analysis skills and will also further develop their ability to organize and manage a research and writing task. Students will deconstruct statutes and common law rules into elements, summarize and synthesize case law, and identify legally relevant facts from a case file to arrive at a sound legal conclusion.
