Course Description: This upper-level course is to assist students in further developing the fundamental writing and analysis skills necessary for success on the bar exam and as lawyers. Using the Multistate Performance Test, students will hone their critical reading and legal analysis skills and will also further develop their ability to organize and manage a research and writing task. Students will deconstruct statutes and common law rules into elements, summarize and synthesize case law, and identify legally relevant facts from a case file to arrive at a sound legal conclusion. Pre-requisite: First year day courses.
