

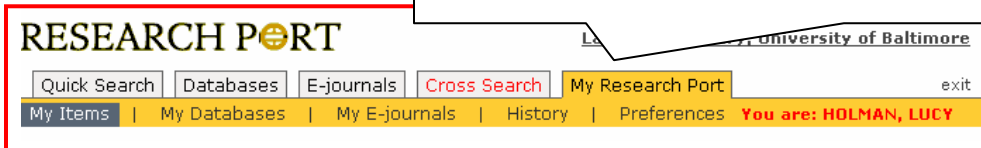


CUSTOMIZING RESEARCH PORT (PORTAL TO LANGSDALE LIBRARY)

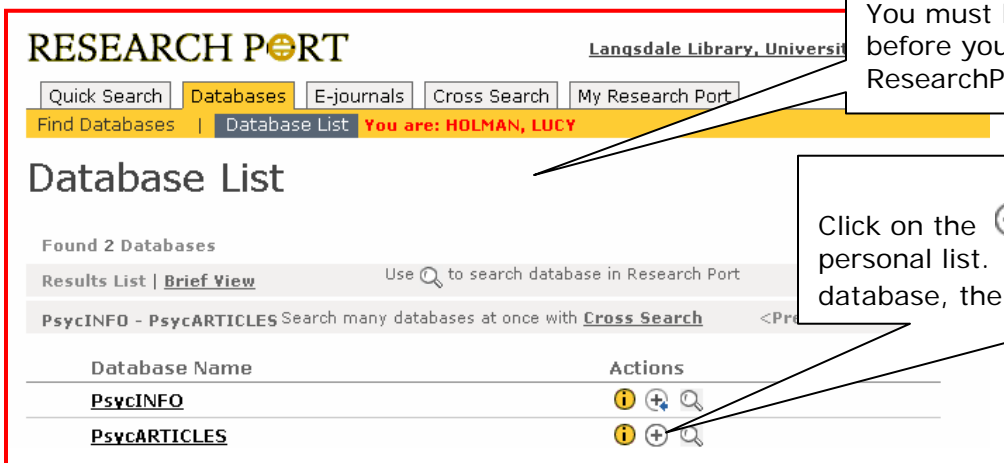
Research Port is the gateway to Langsdale Library's electronic resources. It enables you to access the library's subscription databases and locate additional web resources. This guide will help you customize your own Research Port, adding favorite databases and online journals, storing searches for later use, search alerts and saving articles. For help searching databases in Research Port and finding articles, see Using Research Port or Cross Search in Research Port.

MY RESEARCH PORT:

In My Research Port you'll see the following headings: MY ITEMS, MY DATABASES, MY E-JOURNALS, HISTORY and PREFERENCES. If you are logged in, you may save individual journals, articles you've found, searches you have performed and your preferred databases.

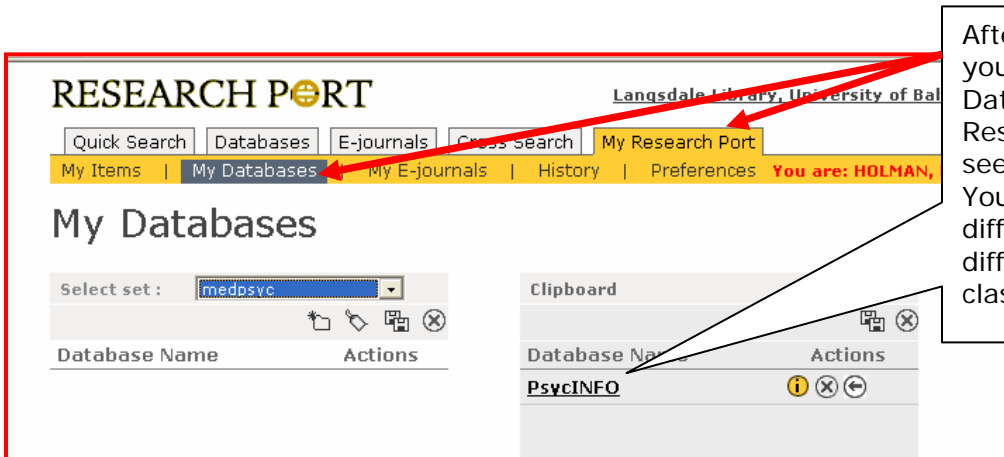


CREATING A PERSONAL SET OF DATABASES:



You must log in to ResearchPort before you can save items in "My ResearchPort."

Click on the + to select a database for your personal list. When you have added a database, the icon will change to +.



After adding the databases you want, click on "My Databases" under the "My Research Port" tab, and you'll see the one(s) you added. You may want to create different sets of databases for different assignments or classes.
