(This tutorial explains how to view your Academic Advisement Report through Self Service.)

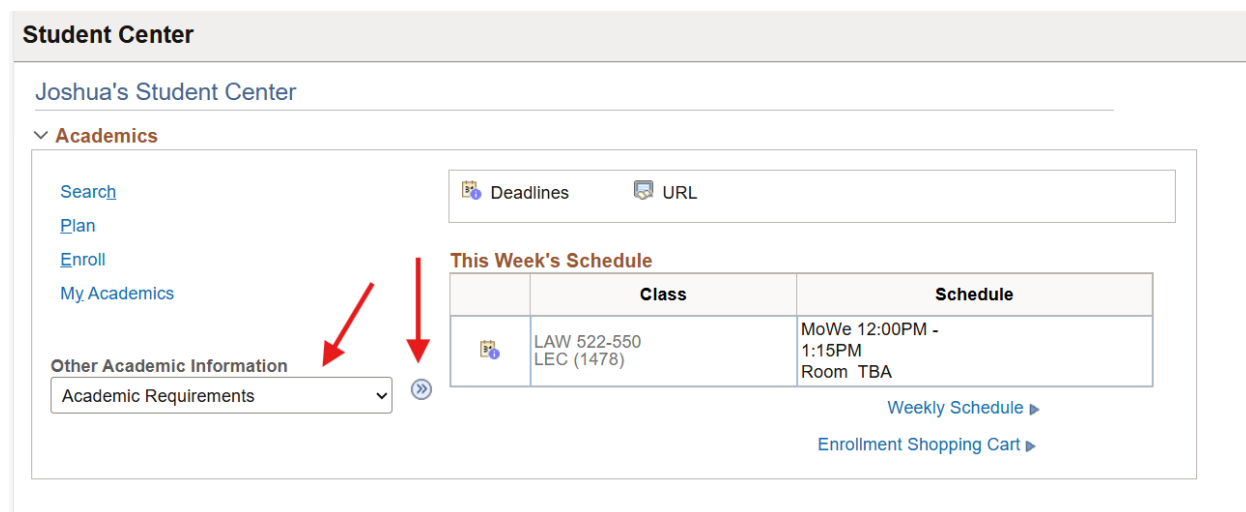
Navigate to the MyUB Homepage by going to the following link:

<https://myubalt.ubalt.edu>. Enter your Network ID and Password.

From the MyUB Portal, select “My Student Center” from the “Most-Used Tools” column.



Under the “Academics” tab of your Student Center, select the drop-down option under the “Other Academic Information” field. Select “Academic Requirements,” then click the two corresponding arrows next to the option to proceed.



On the next page, under the “My Academic Requirements” section, you will be given the options to expand, collapse, or view the report as a PDF.
