

University of Baltimore Undergraduate Student 3.2 Request To Take Graduate Courses

Undergraduate students who have successfully completed 90 applicable credits and earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2 may qualify to enroll in up to six graduate credits to be used as elective undergraduate courses. These graduate credits cannot later be applied to a graduate program at the University of Baltimore. Undergraduate tuition rates will apply.

Students interested in pursuing this option must meet with their advisor, prior to the beginning of the next term, to review their academic qualifications. The request is then forwarded to the undergraduate and graduate program directors to approve or disapprove the student's application. Course registrations will be processed by the Records Office via a registration form signed by both the student and the Academic Advisor.
