

CMAT 489 Directed Independent Study

Students wanting to do an Independent Study need to follow the following procedure:

- 1. Come up with an idea. This may be a paper or a project but must merit enough work to be worthy of 3-credits.
- 2. Write a formal proposal including:
 - a. General Introduction.
 - b. A brief narrative describing the project.
 - c. A statement of the potential audience.
 - d. Detailed treatment, storyboards, roughs, script, or any support material that shows the outline/structure, design, artistic, and technical choices made.
 a. A detailed schedule of completion.
 - e. A detailed schedule of completion.
- 3. Submit that proposal to the faculty member you'd like to direct the project. If he/she agrees, submit the proposal with the signature of that faculty member, to the Program Director.
- 4. If the Program Director approves the project, you'll be cleared to register.
- 5. Plan on this process taking 1-month.
