March 2023 ▶

Facilitated "Learn with Me about ChatGPT" Workshop

Conducted a workshop for faculty to explore generative AI and ChatGPT applications in teaching.

May 2023 ►

Joined Ithaka Cohort
Became part of the Ithaka S+R
Making Al Generative for Higher
Education initiative to advance Al
integration within UBalt.

Winter/Spring 2024 ▶

Published and Presented Research on Al Courses

Shared research findings at various conferences and prepared a journal article (in progress).

Conducted In-Depth Interviews

Completed 12 de-identified interviews across all four schools on Al in teaching, research, and other areas, and provided the data to Ithaka.

▲ April 2023

Designed and Facilitated Al Teaching Talk Series

Organized a weekly one-hour series throughout April focusing on various Al topics related to teaching and learning.

Assessed UBalt AI Landscape

Conducted surveys among faculty, staff, and students to evaluate the current Al environment.

Published White Paper of Findings Released a comprehensive white

<u>paper</u> detailing the survey results and insights.

Created Two 5-Week Asynchronous Al Courses in Canvas LMS

Developed separate Al courses for faculty and students to promote responsible and ethical Al usage.

Piloted and Researched Al Courses

Evaluated the courses to measure knowledge and confidence gains, as well as attitude changes postcompletion.

Published *From Chalkboards to Chatbots* courses in Pressbooks for <u>faculty</u> and <u>students</u>.

Launched Generative AI PLC

Created a collaborative group of faculty to share best practices and deepen understanding of Al in higher education.

Launched Al Work Groups

Created collaborative groups of faculty, staff, and students to determine next steps for Al literacy at UBalt.

June 2025 ▶

Hosted 2nd Annual Al Summit 2025

Organized a <u>one-day event</u> with panels, presentations, and demos featuring State of Maryland leadership along with local industry and community leaders to shape Al integration at UBalt and beyond.
