GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR CREDITS

We've been recognized as a leader within the University System of Maryland in terms of the number of credits we accept and apply toward your degree.

Transfer a total of up to 90 credits from any combination of the following:

- up to 63 lower-division (100- and 200-level) credits from a community college
- up to 70 lower-division credits from a four-year institution
- up to 20 upper-division (300- and 400-level) credits from a four-year institution
- up to 45 acceptable credits in any combination of Credit by Examination and/or nontraditional coursework.

The above is provided as a guideline for planning purposes. Actual credits are contingent upon official course evaluation.

FUNDING YOUR EDUCATION

Work-Study

Students who demonstrate financial need can gain valuable work experience with a work-study position. Funds from your aid package will be set aside for you to earn as you work.

Transfer Merit Scholarships

We recognize high-achieving student performance by awarding generous merit-scholarships to qualified incoming transfer students at the time of admission.

Samuel G. Rose Scholars Award

This scholarship supports undergraduate students who need financial assistance—based on their FAFSA application—to complete their degrees. Award amounts range between \$400 to \$9,000 per year. The award is renewable for future years.

The Bob Parsons Scholarship Fund

This award, designed to support Pell Grant-eligible transfer and military/veteran students, pays the difference between your Pell Grant award and our in-state tuition and fees.

Baltimore City Scholars Program

This program provides Baltimore city government employees, and a select group of nongovernment Baltimore city employees, financial support to further their undergraduate education. Undergraduate applicants must have at least 60 college-level credits, a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, and enroll at least half-time in a degree-granting program.
