FUNDING YOUR EDUCATION

Graduate Merit Scholarships

If you have an exemplary academic record, you may be eligible to receive up to \$5,500 per year.

UBalt Foundation Scholarships

New graduate students may also qualify for various foundation scholarships worth up to \$5,000.
