

2025–2026 Advanced Professional Development Cost of Attendance (COA)

The Cost of Attendance (COA), sometimes referred to as your financial aid budget, is an estimate of the average total cost for you to attend The University of Baltimore (UBalt) for an academic year. The tables below list our estimated 2025-2026 rates. These estimated rates are subject to change pending proposed state legislation and University System of Maryland Board of Regents approval.

Cost of Attendance address both tuition and fees as well as indirect expenses related to going to school that will not appear on your university bill. Estimated student budgets for personal living expenses reflect modest and adequate expense patterns of UBalt students. Personal living is determined by the FAFSA form, if a student is dependent, the housing status will be determine as living with parent. The indirect expenses are based on the 15-week length instructional time each semester. Estimates are based on research conducted by the Office of Financial Aid and include average costs for books, supplies, and other miscellaneous living expenses. These estimated rates are subject to change.
