- T-visa issued to student or T-1 visa issued to student's parent

The following designations are not eligible for financial aid:

- an F1, F2 or M1 student visa
- an Employment Authorization Card (I-688A)
- a J1 or J2 exchange visitor visa
- a G series visa (pertaining to international organizations)
