- **December 2019** CFCC's Truancy Court Program (TCP) held its Fall 2019 graduation ceremonies at each of the five Baltimore City Schools. At Furley Elementary School all 17 TCP students graduated and demonstrated at least a 65% decrease in absences and/or tardies. In total, 75% of TCP students graduated from the program across the five schools.
